

## Video Transcript

Personnel credentials: You'll find this information in the normative annex in Edition 2 of the Certification Protocol. One of the most widely requested updates was to broaden out the opportunities for certifying personnel needed to execute an SEP 50001 program, so we have attempted to do that for you.

Let's start at the very beginning: ISO 50001 Lead Auditor. We are providing two options for each of the certified personnel. For the Lead Auditor, your choices are:

1. The AEE ISO 50001 Lead Auditor course. You can see the URL and QR code available to you there, and it is also available to you in the Certification Protocol.
2. You may also choose any IRCA certified ISO 50001 Lead Auditor course.

What about the SEP 50001 Lead Auditor? This has two steps to it; you don't start with SEP 50001 Lead Auditor. You start first by being an ISO 50001 Lead Auditor, so that would be the AEE course or the IRCA course. Then you get additional training on the SEP 50001 program and the roles and responsibilities of the Lead Auditor and specific requirements of SEP 50001. This may be done through a course provider, such as AEE or Georgia Tech, or it can be done by the Verification Body.

Certified Practitioner is a very important role both within the organization and within the Verification Body. Again, we have two options: one is the 50001 Certified Practitioner in EnMS, and the second is the 50001 Certified Professional. Both of these are offered by AEE.

The choices for SEP Performance Verifier are provided on this screen. Remember, this is also a two-step process. First you must have the CP EnMS, that was the previous slide, then you get the SEP 50001 Performance Verifier. There are two choices for your certification:

1. One is the SEP Performance Verifier, which is offered through AEE. You can see the link and the QR code.
2. The second one is Certified M&V Professional (CMVP), also offered by AEE. However, if you choose this particular pathway, then the Verification Body is responsible for demonstrating the competencies in the current M&V Protocol, Edition 2. That would be done by the VB directly.
