

Video Transcript

Let's talk about the changes to the Measurement and Verification Protocol for the SEP 50001 (2019) Program.

Edition 2 of the M&V Protocol reflects changes that were made to the Certification Protocol. For example, the term SEP 50001 Scheme Owner replaces the SEP 50001 Program Administrator in most places. Elsewhere, in the language about pre-approvals, the role of the Administrator was changed to that of the Verification Body. Clients will now send these requests to the Verification Body instead of to the Administrator.

The rest of the changes show on this slide mainly reflect greater flexibility on unit types and expansion of the program to participants outside of the United States. Units in several diagrams, tables, and equations were adjusted. They were previously shown in U.S. customary units, and now they are also shown in metric units.

Also, some of the references that are very specific to the United States were removed, because they are not going to be relevant to participants in other locations.

What do these all of these changes mean? To summarize:

- There's no change to the competency involved with the M&V.
- There's also no change to the M&V process or methods.
- Finally, the addition of other types of units increases flexibility for users.
